ABOUT DREAM

Dream Project is a mentoring program run by Reledev Australia (an Australian NGO), which connects Australian volunteers to high school students from refugee backgrounds. These teams of university students encourage and support young people from refugee families by helping them to 'fit in' and feel encouraged to learn, grow and develop in a nurturing environment.

5 years on we have:

- Seen 120 volunteers who have mentored and supported students from refugee families.
- 250 refugee students have been mentored across six high schools pre-Covid.

VOLUNTEERING

We are seeking to recruit university students to participate in this worthwhile opportunity to make a real difference in a person's life.

- We are looking for approximately 20 keen volunteers to commit to the mentoring program for at least a year.
- **Mentoring is every Wednesday (1-3.30pm) during school term at Fairfield.**
- Volunteers are trained and supported with 3 training sessions from the core team of Dream who are also volunteers.
